The dirt lot decal may only be good until January, 2010. If they take the lot away from us for construction, these decals will no longer be good to park a vehicle on school grounds.

Bring the following items to the Student Activity Office to purchase a decal.

1. This completed application.
2. Your driver License.
3. The registration for the car you plan to drive to school
4. A copy of your school schedule for 2009-2010.
5. \$35.00 cash

PARKING PERMITS - STUDENT DRIVERS (PARKING IS A PRIVILEGE.)

1. Each student who has received approval to park his/her vehicle in the school's parking lot must have that vehicle identified by a school's parking decal. The cost for a decal is \$35.00 and is obtained from the student activities coordinator. Transfer decals fee is \$5.00.
2. A student is **NOT** permitted to drive an automobile or motorcycle to school without a parking decal. Cars parked on school grounds without decals will be ticketed and/or booted and student will receive disciplinary action.
3. Students with out-of-zone permission will **NOT** receive priority for parking decals, but must complete the same process as other students.
4. Permission to drive must be requested by a parent on a form available in the Student Activities Office from the Student Activities Coordinator. Applications and decals may be picked up from 7:00 am to 7:20 am.
5. Violation of the rules established for student drivers will result in the loss of parking privilege.
6. Students who drive to school and are tardy repeatedly may have their parking decal revoked.
7. The parking decal must be displayed on the outside of the back window in the lower right corner of the car listed on the application (the passenger's side). The vehicle must be parked with the rear bumper facing out. Students may **NOT** pull through a space.
8. Temporary decals can be issued to students with existing decals.
9. Temporary decals will be issued between 7:00 am – 7:20 am & after-school when SAC is available. Students who have late arrival or attend Vo-Tech, ATC, etc. will need to plan ahead.
10. Altering a temporary parking pass may result in parking privileges being revoked.
11. The access road through the dirt parking lot is **ONE WAY**. Do **NOT** exit via this access road.
12. Cutting into the traffic flow or driving over curbs is prohibited.
13. Students are responsible for their vehicle regardless of who is driving.
14. The volume of car sound systems must be kept low while on school grounds.
15. Unauthorized vehicles will be ticketed and/or booted.
16. Decals can be used only on the vehicle to which they are issued. They cannot be given or loaned to another student.
17. Students must park their vehicle in their respectively assigned parking lot. Vehicles parked in reserved/assigned spaces may be ticketed and/or booted.
18. Driving is a privilege and can be revoked as a disciplinary measure.
19. Once the vehicle is parked, the student must leave it and vacate the parking lot.
20. During regular school hours, students are **NOT** permitted to go to the parking lot without a pass **authorized by the administration**.
21. Using a vehicle to leave school grounds without permission or to transport other students off school grounds may result in loss of the driving decal.
22. Speeding may revoke the driving privilege– **Parking Lot Speed is 5 miles per hour.**
23. Upon receiving a parking ticket, the student must see Student Activities Coordinator.
 - 1st Ticket = Copy of violation is filed and serves as student's warning
 - 2nd Ticket = Car may be booted and student is referred for disciplinary review
 - 3rd Ticket = Car is booted and parking privilege can be revoked for the rest of the school year
24. If parking decal is revoked, it might be revoked for the rest of the school year.
25. **If a boot is placed on a vehicle, the boot will not be removed until the parking lot is cleared of traffic.**
26. **During school hours, there will be no left turn into the dirt parking lot from Holland Road.**
