1. Type <http://www.apcentral.collegeboard.com>
2. Go to the left side AP Courses and exams section and click on course home pages.
3. On the Course home page index click on AP Spanish Language.
4. Click on AP Spanish Language Update on Changes to the course and Exam.
5. Read the information related to the course.
6. Scroll down the page to the AP Spanish Language 2009 Exam Format.
7. Click on Short and Long Dialogues and Narratives.
8. Read the information.
9. Scroll down to read the Directions, Question and Source.
10. Click on Audio Prompt. Listen to the audio. You make take notes
11. Answer the test.
12. Check your answers by clicking on answer key.
13. Go back to the Exam Format and click on Reading Comprehension.
14. Read the information.
15. Scroll to the bottom of the page and read the directions and answer the questions.
16. Check your answers by clicking on the answer key.
17. Go back to the Exam Format and click on Informal Writing. Read the information.
18. Scroll to the bottom of the page and read the directions.
19. Write the essay based on the instructions. Remember to **SAVE** all sections of the practice exam to SharePoint, flash drive, CD, etc.
20. You may look at the sample responses to get ideas, but your essay must be original.
21. Look at the scoring commentary to see how you will be evaluated.
22. Go back to the Exam Format and click on Formal Writing. Read the information.
23. Scroll to the bottom of the page and read the directions, question and sources. Read the selections provided.
24. Listen to the Audio Prompt and take notes.
25. Write a well organized **250** word essay based on the instructions. Remember to answer the main question **NOT** summarizing but analyzing **ALL** the sources. You should quote from all the sources. Remember to **SAVE** all sections of the practice exam to SharePoint, flash drive, CD, etc.
26. You may look at the sample responses to get ideas, but your essay must be original.
27. Go back to the Exam Format and click on Informal Speaking. Read the information.
28. Scroll to the bottom of the page and read the directions.
29. Listen to the audio and record your responses in "Audacity", SharePoint, a flash drive, a CD, etc.
30. You may listen to the sample responses for ideas, but yours must be original. Remember I will grade this.
31. Go back to Exam Format and click on Formal Oral Presentation.
32. Read the information. Scroll down and read the directions, question and sources.

33. Read all the sources and take notes.
34. Listen to the audio prompt.
35. You may write an outline organizing all the sources making sure that you are answering the main question.
36. When you are ready, record a 2 minute response, answering the main question in a well organized oral presentation. You must answer the main question using data or quotes from the audio and readings. Save your oral test in "Audacity", Sharepoint, a flash drive or a CD.
37. This assignment will be **due the first week of school on (Thursday or Friday)**. It will count as a quiz grade.
