- After School Academy Courses
- Arts Enrichment Courses and activities
- Summer Enrichment Information
- Governor's Residential School for the Gifted - a summer residential program in the humanities, sciences, and arts at major Virginia universities
- Governor's School for the Arts (GSA) - a year round ½ day magnet school at Old Dominion University and Norfolk State university in dance, theatre, music, visual and performing arts
- Brickell Scholars - a seminar program for selected academic students offered by the Rotary Club
- Listserv messages – weekly updates sent via e-mail providing current information about program opportunities and events
- SPARKS and ThinkTank for SuperThinkers - one-half credit courses offered during lunch/study block. These classes are open to all students who enjoy researching and discussing current/controversial topics.
- Lunch Activities - games, competitions, group discussions, computer/internet resources and homework/study sessions.
- College Prep-PSAT/SAT Assistance - essay writing, resume writing, scholarship and college search information; resources for PSAT/SAT preparation and review
- Independent Study Courses - student-designed research projects that culminate in papers, presentations, seminars, and/or exams
- AP Independent Study Courses - available for students when an AP course is not offered or the class is not available because of scheduling conflicts with other AP course in the school
- Field Trips and Enrichment Opportunities - college campus visits and other opportunities that become available
